The Citizens Appointment Committee met in the City Hall Meeting Room at 4:00 p.m. on June 3, 2019. Mayor Pro Tem Anderson presided.

Item No. 1. Approval of Minutes of Citizens Appointment Committee Regular Meeting of March 4, 2019. Council Member Anthony moved to approve the Minutes of the Citizens Appointment Committee Regular Meeting of March 4, 2019. Council Member Holloway seconded the motion, which passed unanimously with the following votes:

Item No. 2. Consideration of Upcoming Appointments. Council Member Anthony moved to recommend the following:

Council Member Holloway seconded the motion which passed unanimously, with the following votes:

AYES: Council Members Anthony, Holloway and Mayor Pro Tem Anderson
NAYS: None

Item No. 3. City Code Amendment to Impose Term limits on Chairs and Vice-Chairs of the City's Boards and Commissions. Per recommendation from Mayor Pro Tem Anderson, City Attorney Mujeeb Shah-Khan advised that Staff requested direction. He explained that Staff recommended that as of December 31, 2020 the Chair and Vice-Chair would serve until December 31, 2021; however, if having served eight years on the board, they would be removed or could serve one more term if only having served four years. City Attorney Shah-Khan noted that it was the Committee's discretion if they wanted the effective date to be December 31, 2019.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson asked if this would be for all committee members.

City Attorney Shah-Khan advised that it would be for all non-Council Member Chair and Vice-Chairs because every other committee already had the term limits. He noted that the only people exempt from the term limits were the Chairs and Vice-Chairs which Council approved in 2010.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that if the change was effective 2020, then the idea was that the term limits did not come into play until 2021 because there were some people who had served as Chairs of boards and commissions for more than eight years.

City Manager Larry Faison asked if the term of Chair and Vice-Chair was traditionally one year.

City Attorney Mujeeb Shah-Khan advised that traditionally it was four years.

City Manager Faison asked if someone was a chair in 2019, could they continue if this was put into place past 2021.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that they could continue until the end of 2021 and then would then have to be reappointed for another four-year term after 2021.

Council Member Anthony asked what was the difference if it was effective 2019.

City Attorney Shah-Khan explained that it just moved up the date and if the Committee wanted everything to start at the end of 2019 so that if someone had been serving eight years then they were off or wanted to give them a little more time.

Council Member Anthony stated that eight years was a long time to her.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that Staff suggested that it be placed on the agenda for the City Council Regular Meeting of July 16, 2019 if the Committee chose to move forward, so people would have about five months' notice that it was going to happen. He reminded the Committee that this was their decision if they felt that was sufficient notice period for the appointees, giving them an additional year, and then perhaps changing the term limits.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson stated that he preferred 2019 because he felt that was ample notice because his concern was some people had been in those roles a long time and at some point, the City needed to give other people an opportunity.

Council Member Anthony moved to recommend to Council making the City Code amendment to impose term limits on Chairs and Vice-Chairs of the City's Boards and Commissions effective December 31, 2019.

Council Member Holloway stated that certain boards such as the ABC Board were governed by State laws, and if that meant someone had to stay on as Chair or Vice-Chair or be required to step down.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that the ABC Board was subject to the State requirements and believed that it required reappointment and would have to deal with the conflicts between City and State statutes. He advised that there would be a point in time where term limits started to matter and if put into place, Staff suggested a one-year delay so that if someone was in the middle of an issue/project had time to see it to completion; however, that was up to Council.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson felt that it should be equal across all of the committees.

Council Member Holloway felt that having a little more time gave them a chance to complete projects.

Council Member Anthony advised that she preferred 2019 because it would still be six months and if a person had been serving eight years, that was a long time and the Chair did not make decisions alone because the board also helped.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that Staff suggested the implementation to 2020 was because of the interview process and the opportunity to sit in on meeting issues and the reason to make it effective the end of 2019, but folks would get to serve until the end of 2020, but it was going to be the work of the Committee to interview the applicants.

City Attorney Shah-Khan advised that it also depended on if the applicant was filling an unexpired term and typically was fixed in that role and Staff recommended making it effective December 31, 2019; however, changeovers did not take place until 2020 to give more time.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously with the following votes:

4. Interviewing Potential Applicants for Boards and Commissions. City Attorney Shah-Khan advised that at the March 4, 2019 Citizens Appointment Committee Meeting, the Committee approved the interview and attendance requirement prior to an applicant being considered; however, there was no guidance provided to Staff as to who would be conducting the interviews or when.

Mayor Pro Tem Anderson agreed with requiring applicants to attend a board or committee of interest, but was not sure that the Committee should take on the process of interviewing every single applicant.

Council Member Anthony moved to remove the interview requirement from the application form but keep the meeting attendance requirement prior to applying for a board or commission. Council Member Holloway seconded the motion which passed unanimously with the following votes:

AYES: Council Members Anthony, Holloway and Mayor Pro Tem Anderson
NAYS: None

City Manager Faison requested that Staff ensure that the online application also reflected the revision.

5. Public Safety Committee Appointment Rescinded. City Attorney Shah-Khan advised that a member of the Public Safety Committee had only attended one meeting since being appointed on March 5, 2018. He explained that letters were mailed to him on March 11, 2019 and June 18, 2019 advising of removal from the committee due to lack of attendance and as of today, Donald Chatmon had not responded.

Council Member Anthony moved to recommend that Council rescind Donald Chatmon's appointment to the Public Safety Committee due to lack of attendance. Council Member Holloway seconded the motion which passed unanimously with the following votes:

City Attorney Shah-Khan advised that Staff would take the appropriate steps to give Mr. Chatmon additional notice and as a matter of courtesy, Staff would advise him that the item would be on the agenda for the City Council Regular Meeting of July 17, 2019 to rescind his appointment to the Public Safety Committee.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:30 p.m.

Council Member Anthony made a motion to recommend appointment of Terry Sholar to the ABC Board; reappointment of David Covington to the Board of Adjustment; appointment of Carley Englander to the Downtown Advisory Board and appointment of Archie Morgan to the Downtown Advisory Board.

Council Member Anthony stated that she wanted to make a statement and that it was nothing personal against Mr. Anderson, just business; however, she felt it was an impropriety for a Council Member to apply for a board while he was a current Council Member.

City Attorney Shah-Khan stated that with all due respect to Council Member Anthony, it was not an impropriety for Council Member Anderson to apply to be on the General Services Committee due to him not being on the new City Council that would make the final decision based on the recommendations from the Citizens Appointment Committee

Council Member Anthony stated that she did not need to have words placed in her mouth; however, she felt it was the perception.

City Attorney Shah-Khan noted that the use of the term impropriety by the Council Member connoted wrongdoing on behalf of another member, where none existed, and as such, suggested that another term might be more appropriate.

Following discussion, Council Member Anthony revised her original motion to include the appointment of Gary Anderson to the General Services Committee.

Council Member Holloway seconded the motion, which passed unanimously with the following votes:
