MEETING MINUTES
September 18, 2025**

The Public Safety Committee met on September 18, 2025, at 4:15 p.m. in the City Hall Large Conference Room.

Chairman David Dotson called the meeting to order at 4:43 p.m.

Item 1: Minutes from August 4, 2025 Meeting

Council Member Anderson made a motion to approve the minutes of the Public Safety Committee meeting of August 4, 2025. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 2: Union County Interlocal Agreement

Fire Chief Fowler presented to the Committee a Interlocal Agreement with Union County in the amount of \$75,000. Chief Fowler, on behalf of the fire department, requested the Committee recommend that Council accept the \$75,000 and approve BA-2025-27 and to appropriate and designate these funds to Fire expenditure accounts. Council Member Anderson made a motion to place this item on the Council agenda for approval. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 3: Budget Amendment – Donation for Fire Explorers

Fire Chief Fowler presented to the Committee a donation of \$500 from Council Member Anderson’s discretionary funds to be used in support of the Fire Explorer’s Program. Chairman Dotson made a motion to forward to Council for approval and to designate the funds to the Fire Department expenditure account. Council Member Anderson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 4: Automatic Aid Agreement with Griffith Road Volunteer Fire Department

Fire Chief Fowler presented to the Committee an Automatic Aid Agreement with Griffith Road Volunteer Fire Department for structure fire response for areas off of Sunset Drive. Under this agreement, response time to those areas off Sunset Drive would improve. This agreement would also have a positive effect on property owner’s fire insurance rates. Council Member Anderson made a motion to forward to Council for approval of the Agreement. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 5: Reduced Conflict Intersections at US 74, Morgan Mill Road and Walkup Avenue

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee a request for consideration of support for a safety project along US Hwy 74 with two intersections at Morgan Mill Road and Walkup Avenue. The proposed project would provide pedestrian accommodations where none exist today. Council Member Anderson made a motion to forward to Council to support the RCI project along US Hwy 74. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 6: Ordinance to Amend Traffic Code – Chapter 75: Traffic Schedules – Schedule II: Through Streets

Engineering Associate Chad Splawn presented to the Committee an Ordinance Amendment to include the streets within Woodlands Creek, Waverly and Alexander Commons neighborhoods that were accepted for maintenance in August 2025. Chairman Dotson made a motion to approve the Ordinance Amendment O-2025-48, and to place the proposed amendment on the consent agenda at the October 14, 2025 meeting. Council Member Anderson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 7: Ordinance to Amend Traffic Code – Chapter 75: Traffic Schedules. Schedule I. Speed Limits (A) State Maintained Streets and (B) City Maintained Streets

Engineering Associate Chad Splawn presented to the Committee and Ordinance Amendment to Chapter 75: Traffic Schedules, Schedule I. Speed Limits (A) State Maintained Streets to add Secret Shortcut Road and (B) City Maintained Streets to add the remaining streets in the Woodlands Creek Neighborhood. Council Member Anderson made a motion to approve the Ordinance Amendment O-2025-37, and to place the proposed amendment on the consent agenda at the October 14, 2025 Council meeting. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 8: Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Agreement and Budget Amendment

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee a request for authorization of the City Manager to execute the grant agreement for Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant and approval of budget amendment. This grant would be used to develop a comprehensive safety action plan focused on improving roadway safety for all users by reducing and eliminating serious injury and fatal crashes. Council Member Anderson made a motion to recommend authorization of the City Manager to execute the SS4A City of Monroe Grant Agreement and approve Budget Amendment AB-2025-33 and place this item on the consent agenda for City Council at the October 14, 2025 meeting. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 9: Interlocal Agreement – Hornyak Drive

Engineering Associate Chad Splawn presented to the Committee a request to consider entering into an Interlocal agreement with the Town of Unionville to allow the City of Monroe to accept a 268 foot section of Hornyak Drive located within the town limits of Unionville for maintenance and to allow the City Manager to execute the agreement for the Resolution. Council Member Anderson made a motion to recommend authorization of the City Manager to execute the agreement and endorse the Interlocal Agreement and place this item on the consent agenda for City Council at the October 14, 2025 meeting. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 10: Request to Award the Purchase of a Mini-Excavator

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee that the Street Division has the replacement of a 2011 mini-excavator included in the budget for FY26 that was budgeted for \$106,500. A 2025 model has been identified that meets all the needs and specifications for the Street Division in the amount of \$104,000. Director McAllister is requesting the Committee approve the award of the mini-excavator in the amount of \$104,000 and authorize the City Manager to execute any and all documents. Chairman Dotson made a motion to place this item on the Council agenda for approval. Council Member Anderson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 11: Award of 2025 – 2026 Resurfacing Contract

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee a request to consider a proposed Budget Ordinance for the bids received for the resurfacing contract and award the contract for the 2025 – 2026 Asphalt Paving Program to True Rock Construction, LLC. Also, authorize a contingency allowance in the amount of \$100,000 and authorize the City Manager to execute all documents, including contract and future change orders if required. Council Member Anderson made a motion to forward to Council for approval. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 12: Proposed Pavement Management Services Contract

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee a request to consider awarding a contract to Roadway Asset Services to provide pavement management consulting services, in the amount of \$129,594. In addition, Director McAllister requested approval of the

City Manager to authorize any and all necessary documents. Council Member Anderson made a motion to forward to Council for approval. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

Item 13: Update on Jefferson Street, Charlotte Avenue, Franklin Street Intersection

For informational purposes only, no action is needed.

Item 14: NC200 (MLK/Dickerson) and Charlotte Ave

Engineering Director Sarah McAllister presented to the Committee two concepts for improving NC200 (MLK/Dickerson) and Charlotte Ave. For informational purposes only.

There being no further business, Council Member Anderson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Chairman Dotson seconded the motion, which passed unanimously, and the meeting was adjourned at 5:16 p.m.

SUMMARY STATEMENT

The Public Safety Committee is requested to consider information related to the purchase of a four door 2026 Ram 5500 crew truck for the Engineering Department – Street Division.

REVIEW

The Engineering Department – Street Division has the replacement of a 2012 F-550 included in the Street Division’s budget for FY 26. The crew truck was budgeted at \$110,000. A 2026 Ram 5500 has been identified that meets all the needs and specifications for the Street Division through Sourcewell Contract 0921521-NAFG. Sourcewell is a purchasing cooperative that competitively bids equipment that meets the statutory requirements. The program is open to use for all city and county agencies.

National Auto Fleet Group (the vendor) and Sourcewell have entered into an agreement for the procurement of the crew truck. A quote was recently received from National Auto Fleet Group in the amount of \$101,254.93 for a 2026 Ram 5500 that meets the needs of the Street Division. Funds are available in the FY 26 Powell Bill Capitalized Motor Vehicles account.

RECOMMENDATION

The Public Safety Committee is requested to approve the following:

- 1) Award of the 2026 Ram 5500 in the amount of \$101,254.93 to National Auto Fleet Group through the Sourcewell Contract 0921521-NAFG.

2) Authorization of the City Manager to execute any and all necessary documents.

If the Public Safety Committee is in agreement, this item will be placed on the consent agenda for Council approval on November 10, 2025.
