Item No. 2. General Updates

Tonya Edwards, Parks and Recreation Director provided a brief update on the following project:

The Parks Williams Athletic Complex –Monroe Aquatics & Fitness Center Greenway Connector is scheduled to be completed by the first of January. There were several delays with this project due to items needing to be reinstalled by contractor that did not meet design specifications as well as weather related delays. Once the contractor completes the final punch list items and both the City and the consulting firm have signed off on the final approval, our staff will begin installing benches, banners, and additional signage ahead of the official opening for this segment of greenway.

The Belk Tonawanda Park Renovation/Expansion Phase 1-A project is also nearing completion. A final walk through is scheduled for early January and we anticipate all punch list items to be completed at

this location by the end of January.
